



# Common Human Resource Information Standards

## Person Social Security Number

Person Social Security Number [is] a unique number assigned by Social Security Administration (SSA) to identify a person when reporting wages, paying taxes and collecting benefits.

### Permitted Values

NA

### Structural Business Rules

Person Social Security Number must have nine digits. (DoDI 1000.13, Para. E5.1.3)

Person Social Security Number must be uniquely assigned to no more than one person at a time. (DoDI 1000.13, Para. E5.1.3)
