Person Casualty Category

Person Casualty Category is a reporting classification based upon a person's casualty type and casualty status.

Permitted Values

- Accident
- Beleaguered
- Besieged
- Captured
- Detained
- Died of Wounds Received in Action
- Homicide
- Illness
- Interned
- Killed in Action
- Missing in Action
- Pending
- Self-Inflicted
- Terrorist
- Undetermined
- Wounded in Action

Structural Business Rules

Casualty Type must have an associated Casualty Status and Casualty Category.

Casualty Type, Casualty Status, and Casualty Category must have an associated Casualty Date.

Casualty Status and Casualty Category must be determined after Casualty Type is established.

See Casualty Type / Casualty Status / Casualty Category Tabular Business Rule for existing relationship constraints between Casualty Type, Casualty Status, and Casualty Category.
