Member Legal Charge Disposition

Member Legal Charge Disposition is the resolution of a charge identified in the Manual for Courts Martial in which a DoD Military Service member is the subject.

Permitted Values

Guilty
 Not guilty but guilty of a violation of Article
 Not guilty only for reason of lack of mental responsibility
 Not guilty

Structural Business Rules

A Member Legal Charge Identifier must have a Member Legal Charge Disposition when a member is the subject of a non-judicial punishment or courts martial.
