### Person Authorized to Direct Disposition Relationship Name

Person Authorized to Direct Disposition (PADD) Relationship Name is the name of the relationship between a DoD Military Service member and a person for whom the DoD Military Service member elects to receive his/her remains in the case of the member's death.
