Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Category is an accounting and programming classification for Active Duty DoD Military Service members within a DoD Military Service.

Structural Business Rules

A Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Category must have only one associated Member Duty Status at a time.

A DoD Military Service member must have only one Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Category at a time.

Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Category is used to establish the Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Gain Date and Member Active Duty Personnel Strength Loss Date.
